Participation fee of the programm in Riga is 395, - € pp. and will take place if the required ammount of participants join the event (40 persons)

The participation fee includes transfers from Spilve Airport. For those arriving at Riga International Airport, public transport or taxis can be used. Upon arrival at Spilve Airport, you will be welcomed with tasty snacks and drinks.

The package features a guided tour of both beautiful Riga and relaxing Sigulda, along with a program at Sigulda Aerodium (indoor skydiving available for an additional fee ??). You'll also get to explore Riga's history with entrance tickets to the Museum of Occupation and the Riga Motor Museum included, and transfers from place to place. Additionally, the fee covers the Sigulda Air Tram ticket, two dinners, and a lunch.
